Outside, the garden offers space to relax, socialise or get involved in gardening, and a company vehicle is available for day trips.

Step 2.

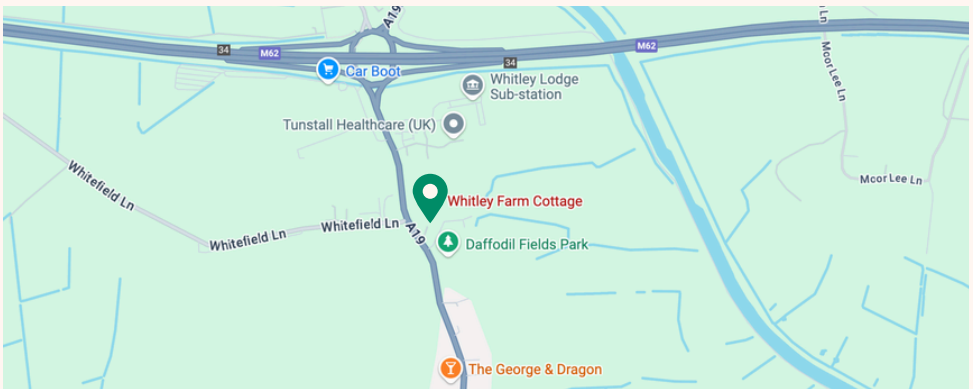


If all involved feel the move should take place, you'll be invited to visit the home and the local area to see if you like it.
