Set in a residential area of Newport, The Beeches is a large, detached supported living home for up to five adults.

Designed for shared living, it offers communal areas where people can relax, connect, and feel truly at home.

With shared lounges and a communal kitchen, people are supported to shape everyday life in ways that feel meaningful and achievable - from planning meals and building routines,

to spending time in the community and enjoying the buzz of city life nearby.

Support is delivered by a dedicated team who take time to understand what matters to each person. Guided by our unique Strive model, we focus on helping people feel safe and stable, build skills, strengthen relationships, and stay well - with clinical nursing expertise available when needed for reassurance and joined-up, holistic care.

- Someone building independence through practical daily living skills.
