# Welcome to Maes-y-Coed



For people who flourish in quieter environments, Maes-y-Coed offers a calm and supportive home where understanding and personalised support helps people feel settled and connected.



At Maes-y-Coed, home is about feeling comfortable and understood. Supporting up to three people with learning disabilities, autism and mental health needs, this peaceful semi-detached home sits within a quiet hillside setting overlooking Ebbw Vale.

The home offers three bedrooms, an open plan lounge / dining space, a shared kitchen and three communal bathrooms, where people can enjoy both companionship and personal space. The smaller household setting helps create consistency, familiarity and a strong

sense of belonging. People are supported to make choices, develop confidence and take part in the things that matter most to them, whether that's spending time in the community, pursuing interests or building life skills.

Our approach combines the expertise of dedicated colleagues, in-house Positive Behaviour Support (PBS) specialists and multidisciplinary professionals.

Through our Strive model of care, we focus on helping people feel safe, and empowered to live a fulfilling life.
