Blamsters Cottage is a two-bed residential home in Halstead for adults with learning disabilities, autism, mental health needs and complex support needs.

Set across two floors, the home offers a balance of shared living and personal space. On the ground floor, there is a shared kitchen, and person also has their own lounge, bedroom and shower room, creating space to relax, recharge and make the home feel truly their own.

As part of the wider Blamsters Farm involve community, the Cottage offers connection while retaining the calm and familiarity of a smaller home.

Support is guided by Strive, our model of support, alongside specialist PBS, a trauma-informed approach and input from our MDT. Together, these help us understand people's needs so we can support them to lead a flourishing life.

Your journey starts with a referral from your care team. We'll then arrange a meeting with you to see if the home is a good match.

Step 2.

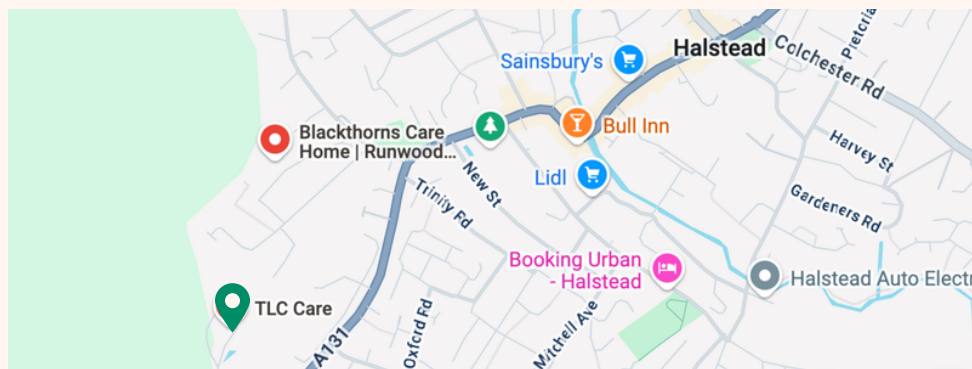


If all involved feel the move should take place, you'll be invited to visit the home and the local area to see if you like it.
