Welcome to The Hollies



The Hollies is a wheelchair-accessible supported living home in Newport, where adults with learning disabilities, autism and complex neurological needs can build independence and enjoy life on their own terms. ☆

In a quieter corner of Newport, The Hollies offers a spacious, accessible home where people can make choices and feel a sense of belonging. The main house has five bedrooms, four with ensembles, alongside an assisted bathroom, a shared lounge and kitchen, wide hallways and ramped access for wheelchair users.

At the rear, a self-contained annex provides an open-plan kitchen and living area, bedroom and ensuite, creating greater privacy while keeping support

close by. An enclosed garden offers space for fresh air, quiet moments and time together.

An established support team brings consistency and a strong understanding of complex physical and neurological needs. Guided by our Strive model, support focuses on building meaningful independence. In-house PBS, MDT input and trauma-informed practice help the team understand each person's story and provide calm, thoughtful support that adapts as needs change.

This is ideal for...

- A wheelchair user who benefits from a spacious, accessible home.
- Those with learning disabilities or physical / neurological needs.
- A person that needs PBS-informed support for behaviours of concern.
- Someone comfortable sharing a home alongside personal space.
- A person compatible with routine, lively housemate dynamics.

Shared living with more choice

Five bedrooms including four ensembles and a private annex offer flexible living spaces shaped around accessibility, comfort and independence.
