Welcome to The Rookery

The Rookery is a CQC-rated Good, 7 bed residential home in Eccles, supporting adults with learning disabilities, mental health and complex needs with greater stability, confidence so they can enjoy life.

The Rookery offers a calm, supportive setting for seven adults, including people who may be moving on after hospital. Each bedroom has its own ensuite for private space, while one ground-floor room supports accessible living.

The home has two communal lounges, including a quiet room for watching films, or simply stepping away from busier shared spaces. A generous kitchen and dining area brings everyday routines together, and the large garden offers relaxed time outdoors.

Support is available around the clock from trained colleagues who understand varied communication preferences, sensory needs and complex support requirements.

Through Strive, our model of support, we combine specialist PBS, trauma-informed practice and MDT input. This joined-up approach helps each person feel safer strengthens independence and supports them to build a life with more choice, meaning and possibility.

This is ideal for...

- Adults with learning disabilities, mental health or dual diagnoses.
- People who require a carefully planned hospital transition.
- Individuals needing consistent support with communication, sensory or emotional needs.
- People who enjoy shared activities but also value quieter spaces.
- Adults compatible with a mixed-gender residential setting.
