Welcome to Wolsey House



Close to the heart of Eccles, Wolsey House is a 6-bed residential home where adults with learning disabilities, mental health needs and complex needs can build confidence and share everyday moments.



Wolsey House offers a sociable setting for six adults, where each room has its own ensuite for private, personal space.

Two comfortable lounges create room for shared activities, while the communal kitchen and dining area bring people together through cooking, conversation and everyday routines. An additional shared bathroom and garden provide further communal areas for connection.

Life at Wolsey House is shaped around the person. Our skilled team takes time

to understand each individual, providing personalised support around the clock.

Through Strive, our model of support, people are encouraged to build daily living skills, confidence and greater independence at a pace that feels right.

In-house PBS expertise, trauma-informed practice and a MDT approach help create thoughtful, proactive care that supports stability, wellbeing and meaningful progress within a reassuring and friendly home.

- Adults with learning disabilities, mental health needs or dual diagnoses.
- People comfortable living in a mixed-gender shared home.
- Individuals who value connection while also enjoying their own space.
- People who enjoy activities, outings, holidays and shared experiences.
