Welcome to Gilders

Gilders is a welcoming four-bedroom supported living home in Takeley, offering thoughtful support for adults with mental health needs to build confidence, routine and greater independence.

At Gilders, everyday life has a calm, homely rhythm, with space to connect and room to step away when needed.

The four-bedroom home includes two en-suite bedrooms, two bedrooms sharing a bright bathroom, a welcoming kitchen, cosy living room, utility room, games room and peaceful zen room. Outside, the garden offers another place to unwind, chat or enjoy fresh air.

Support here is shaped around each person's goals, whether that means

managing appointments and medication, building daily living skills or moving towards work and greater independence.

Our Strive model keeps support purposeful and personal, while our in-house PBS team work with the wider MDT to bring specialist insight when needed.

A trauma-informed approach helps colleagues understand each person's experiences, creating steady, respectful support that builds trust, confidence and meaningful progress at their own pace.



This is ideal for...

- Someone with mental health needs seeking support in the community.
- A person building independence with appointments, medication and everyday routines.
- Someone easy-going who enjoys shared meals and activities.
- A person who values social connection alongside private space
- Someone who enjoys walks, games, outings and socialising with others.
