Welcome to New Station House

New Station House is a spacious supported living home in Newport, where adults with learning disabilities, autism and complex needs can enjoy meaningful routines and grow their independence.

New Station House supports seven people, in a layout designed to balance shared living and independence.

The main house includes a wheelchair-accessible ground-floor bedroom with an en-suite shower room, a welcoming lounge, separate dining room, kitchen and large utility area, with four further bedrooms upstairs.

A self-contained two-bedroom annexe offers additional privacy, with en-suite facilities and its own living space. An

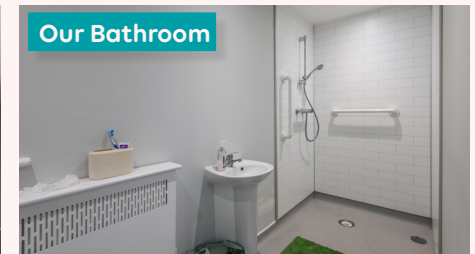
accessible garden gives everyone room to relax outdoors.

Support is guided by our Strive model and shaped around people's strengths, communication and goals. An experienced team helps people build everyday skills, access work, college and community activities, and feel confident trying new things.

Our in-house PBS, MDT and trauma-informed approach brings specialist insight on complex needs.
