Welcome to The Willows

The Willows is a peaceful two-bedroom supported living home in Ebbw Vale, offering women a calm, close-knit setting to build confidence, independence and community connections.

Just outside Ebbw Vale town centre, The Willows offers a settled home where two people can share life without feeling overwhelmed. Set across two floors, the home has two bedrooms and a shared bathroom upstairs, with a comfortable shared lounge and dining area, kitchen and small patio garden downstairs.

Its close-knit setting suits people who value calm routines, familiar faces and gentle encouragement, while the nearby community creates opportunities for

learning, social connection and growing independence.

Support is shaped around each person's strengths, choices and ambitions, with our Strive model helping turn everyday moments into meaningful progress. A consistent team is supported by involve's specialist in-house PBS team, working with MDTs using a trauma-informed approach to create thoughtful, joined-up support that builds trust and independence at a pace that feels genuinely right.

- A woman in her 20s or 30s seeking shared supported living.
- Someone with a learning disability, autism or low-level mental health.
- A person who likes calm routines, predictability and encouragement
- Someone compatible with a female housemate and quiet shared living.
- A person building confidence with community access, learning and independence.
