Woodseats Lodge is a residential home in Norton Lees, Sheffield, offering 8 ensuite bedrooms.

There's homely communal spaces including lounges, a dining area, a games room and kitchen, giving people choice in how they spend their day.

Outside, the enclosed garden and patio create space for fresh air and relaxation. Sharing its site with sister home Norton strengthens the community feel.

A consistent support team builds trusted relationships around each person's routines, interests and goals.

Through Strive, our trauma-informed approach, in-house PBS team work with wider MDTs, to understand what helps each person feel safe, communicate well and grow in confidence in a calm, capable and supportive environment. All this is championed by an active, trauma-informed approach, designed to help people live meaningful lives.

This is ideal for...

- Adults with autism or learning disabilities that need consistent, person-centred support.
- People who enjoy sociable living while also valuing quiet space
- Those who enjoy shared activities and lively everyday routines.
- Adults with mental health needs requiring thoughtful support.
- Mobile adults, comfortable in a mix-gender, long-term home.
